

First Record of *Phenacoccus parvus* Morrison (Hemiptera: Coccoidea: Pseudococcidae) from the Palaearctic Region

The lantana mealybug, *Phenacoccus parvus* Morrison (Hemiptera: Coccoidea: Pseudococcidae), was described from the Galapagos Islands in the Neotropical region by Morrison (5), while its junior synonym, *Phenacoccus surinamensis* Green (4), has been described from Suriname. Since then this mealybug has been recorded from tropical and subtropical territories in South and Central America, West Indies, Florida (USA), Africa, the Tropical South Pacific, Australia and South East Asia (1,3,7,8).
