

## **First Report in Israel of Aralia Leaf-spot Caused by *Alternaria panax***

Aralia leaf-spot, a disease known on several species of Araliaceae in the continental U.S.A. and Hawaii, is reported here as a new occurrence on *Aralia* sp. in Israel. The causal agent, *Alternaria panax*, was isolated from leaf spots and identified using conidial morphology.
